The survey was part of the Faith Communities Today initiative, where various faith groups each survey their constituency then collectively create a larger national sample of religious congregations. The megachurch portion of Faith Communities Today, represented by this survey, was administered jointly by the Hartford Institute for Religion Research, where Scott Thumma is a primary researcher, and Leadership Network, where Warren Bird is research director. The survey was fielded by mail and email during February to April 2011, asking a key informant to complete the questionnaire. Of 1,611 churches contacted, 336 responded or 21%. The responses were weighted by denomination and geography against the known universe of North American megachurches.
